Frank Mulholland will reflect on his time as Lord Advocate and Scotland’s most senior Law Officer.

Frank Mulholland was admitted a solicitor in 1984 and joined the Fiscal Service. In 1991 he transferred to the Crown Office and was appointed an advocate depute in 1995. In 2005 he became a QC. In 2006 he was appointed Area Fiscal for Lothian and Borders and in 2007 Solicitor General. In 2011 he was appointed Lord Advocate. In May 2016 it was announced that he was to be appointed a Senator of the College of Justice, with the appointment taking effect later in the year.
