## Community Justice Scotland

**Karyn McCluskey, Chief Executive**



**Karyn McCluskey** was appointed Chief Executive of Community Justice Scotland in September 2016. She previously worked in the police for 21 years, latterly as the Director of the Scottish Violence Reduction Unit. She is a member of the WHO Violence Prevention Alliance. She helped set up Medics Against Violence charity in Scotland, which attends schools to give inputs on violence reduction, injury and keeping safe. In 2009 she was seconded to the Metropolitan Police to develop a violence plan. She has published work on Armed Robbery teams, Alcohol and Violence interventions in a clinical setting and Violence Reduction. She is Non-Executive Director at Scottish Professional Football League and a board member of Simon Community Scotland tackling homelessness. Community Justice Scotland will formally launch in April 2017.
