Craig Naylor joined Lothian and Borders Police in 1989, serving in a variety of posts. In 2017 he was appointed Assistant Chief Constable in Lincolnshire Police and was promoted to Deputy Chief Constable in 2018. In 2019 he joined the National Crime Agency as Deputy Director of Investigations and was strategic lead for Operation Stovewood, the investigation into child sexual abuse in Rotherham. He was appointed HM Chief Inspector of Constabulary in Scotland in 2022. He is Scotland's senior advisor on policing.

In his talk Craig Naylor will consider the steps he feels are necessary to address institutional discrimination in policing. He will discuss the Policing Together strategy and workstream within Police Scotland, and the progress being made towards an anti-discriminatory organisation.

The aim of SASO is to bring together people with a wide range of experience in the criminal justice system so that by listening, talking and sharing experience, a better understanding of our common problems will develop.
