Stuart Allardyce is a Director of the child protection charity Lucy Faithfull Foundation. He heads up Stop It Now! services in Scotland and is responsible for UK research. He is a visiting researcher at Strathclyde University and the chair of the National Organisation for the Treatment of Abuse (NOTA), the membership association for practitioners in UK and Ireland who work with individuals who have committed sexual offences. He is lead author of "Working with Children and Young People Who Have Displayed Harmful Sexual Behaviour" (Dunedin Press, 2018), and has published more than 20 articles, peer reviewed publications and book chapters. He was a member of the Scottish Government's Expert Group on Preventing Sexual Offending Involving Children and Young People. The Group's report was published in January 2020.

The aim of SASO is to bring together people with a wide range of experience in the criminal justice system so that by listening, talking and sharing experience, a better understanding of our common problems will develop.
