Graeme Pearson is a former police officer and Director General of the Scottish Crime and Drug Enforcement Agency. He is a Labour politician who served as a Member of the Scottish Parliament for the South Scotland Region from 2011 to 2016, and was appointed to the position of Shadow Cabinet Secretary for Justice in June 2013. Graeme also served as Chief Executive of *Scotland in Union* (now known as *Scotland in the Union*) from January to August 2017.
